FOLIAR FEEDING		
Sowing	Direct drilling and transplanting	
1 st two weeks	Kic start - 2ml/L water Fosfaspray - 5g/L water Sporekill - 0.5ml/L water	
1 st Month	Nitrospray – 2ml/L water Hyperfeed – 5g/L water Hygroboost Flo- 2ml/L water Seamaxx – 2.5ml/L water	
2 nd Month	Hyperfeed - 5g/L water Sporekill -1ml/L water Calmabon- 2ml/L water Liquicop -2ml/1L water	
3 rd Month	Sporekill -1ml/L water Calmabon- 2ml/L wate Coptrace - 2ml/1L water
